This is the story of the eccentric novelist Dr William Gordon-Stables. Born in 1837, Stables was a prolific writer of adventure stories. Having trained as a medical doctor in Scotland, he joined the navy in Portsmouth as a Naval Surgeon. On retiring ashore in 1871 he commissioned the building of a gypsy caravan to his own design and travelled around the country with his dog, Hurricane Bob, his valet and coachman in the unique caravan named The Wanderer.
