There may be demonstrations, a chance to have a go yourself or information about events or courses.

PLANNING YOUR OWN TRAIL

you have a foldout map of the whole Trail with a list of **Artists by Venue**. If you wish to visit specific artists, they can all be found in the **Alphabetical List of Artists** at the front. Or, if you prefer particular types of art, there is an index of **Artists by Category** at the back.

ONLINE TRAIL
