## Schedule

- 1 Six different varieties of daffodil/narcissi from any divisions, to be staged in separate vases, (see note 2)
- 2 Two vases of daffodil/narcissi, 3 blooms each vase, 1 distinct variety per vase, (see note 2)
- 3 1 Vase of 3 different varieties of daffodil/narcissi, any divisions, ( see note 1)
- 4 1 bloom - All yellow trumpet daffodil from division 1 (see note 1)
- 5 1 bloom - White or Bi-coloured daffodil from division 1 (see note 1)
- 6 1 bloom - Large cupped daffodil from division 2 (see note 1)
- 7 1 bloom - Small cupped daffodil from division 3 (see note 1)
- 8 1 bloom - Double daffodil from division 4 (see note 1)
- 9 1 bloom - Daffodil from any other division not as described above
- 10 1 vase of 3 stems, multiheaded daffodils, any variety
- 11 1 Vase of miniature daffodils, 3 stems, any variety
- 12 1 vase of Tulips, 3 blooms of one variety
- 13 One stem of flowering shrub
- 14 Vase of 3 shrub stems, any kind or kinds
- 15 3 Rhubarb, forced or natural, (see note 3)
- 16 An exhibit of any one kind of vegetable (not less than 2 in number)
- 17 Vase of garden flowers not to exceed 15" wide
18. Floating Flowerheads in entrant's own bowl not to exceed 12" wide

### Tips for the exhibitor

Condition your flowers. Sloping cut the day before and leave stems in water overnight

Daffodils should be free of dirt and damage.

Aim for symmetry within cup and petals.

Colours clear, not fading or burnt.

If you are unsure which division to enter your daffodil into, bend down one of the petals and compare the length of the cup against the length of the petal.

### Childrens' classes:

- 19 1 pot of daffodils
- 20 Flower arrangement in entrants own Egg Cup
- 21 An animal made from fruits and/or vegetables

### Family class:

- 22 Garden sculpture or model made from recycled materials.  
Any size as may be displayed outside

## Notes Section

### Note 2 Staging

Tiered staging provided for classes 1 + 2.  
Vases provided see rule 3

### Note 3

Pull don't cut, leave root joint attached,  
75mm of green top.

### Note 1 Daffodil Divisions 1 - 4



#### Division 1

##### Trumpet Daffodil

One flower to a stem  
Cup (Trumpet) as long or longer than the petals



#### Division 2

##### Large Cupped Daffodil

One flower to a stem  
Cup more than one-third but less than equal to the length of the petals



#### Division 3

##### Small-cupped Daffodil

One flower to a stem  
Cup not more than one-third the length of the petals



#### Division 4

##### Double Daffodil

One or more flowers to a stem with doubling of the petals, or the cup or both

## Entry Rules:

- 1 Only one entry per exhibitor, per class
- 2 Entry forms must be received by midday **Wednesday 29th March**.  
Late entries may not be accepted
- 3 Vases and staging will be provided for exhibitors to use. Vases are to be signed for and **MUST** be returned at the end of the show:
  - Small size, green vase to be used for vases of 1 bloom or miniatures
  - Medium size, green vase to be used for vases of 3 or more blooms
  - Large size, green vase to be used for classes 14 and 17
- 4 All entries must have been produced/grown by the exhibitor.
- 5 The organisers shall not be held responsible for any loss or damage, all decisions of the judge regarding the merits of exhibits is absolutely final.
- 6 Class 19 is open to children under 16 years
- 7 All exhibits are to be displayed as attractively as possible, it is advisable to use paper, moss or floral foam in vases to support stems. All cut stems must be shown in water. **NO ARTIFICIAL SUPPORTS ABOVE THE VASE ARE ALLOWED.**
- 8 All technical aspects of presenting produce for show is available in the most recent 2016 edition of the RHS Horticultural show handbook, the merits of exhibits are to be judged in conjunction with this book. Please see daffodil division descriptions in the notes section of this schedule.
- 9 Judges must use and fill in the points cards provided when judging classes 1 and 2.
